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## TEACHING ON “**RIGHTEOUSNESS**” BY PASTOR JOHN DANIEL 25-12-1997

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The word *“righteousness”* is called *“DIKAIOSUNE”* in Greek, and pronounced (DIK-AH-YOSOO-NAY), meaning equity or equitable in or of character or act. This means innocent, just, meet, right, etc. Equity means fairness, right judgment, while equitable means fair, just, reasonable. Righteousness therefore means having a fairness of character or just, reasonable, innocent, right act that can make you appear before or approach God without having any feeling of guilt or inferiority complex. Inferiority complex according to Oxford dictionary, means a state of mind in which a person who has a morbid (diseased or unhealthy) feeling of being inferior to others may try to win recognition for himself by boasting and being aggressive. When God created man, He acted on the principle of grace and truth, and covered man with His divine righteousness (glory) and man inherited what he did not work for. Man was naked (in sin) at the time of creation (Gen.2:25), but never felt ashamed (inferior). Why? This is because the glory of God or the righteousness of God was covering him and therefore he could approach God without feeling any guilt or inferior. Again, he did not have a sense of condemnation at that time. It is this sense of condemnation that makes one or a sinner to have a feeling of inferiority complex and by so doing, instead of being a bravado, he will be a coward.

Gen.3:7-13 :- The moment Adam and Eve sinned against God by breaking His commandments, their sense organs became open and not only could they see themselves physically naked, but they also

ion or sin consciousness. This sense of consciousness produced in them inferiority complex immediately, and they began to seek for a way of escape by sowing fig leaves together and making themselves aprons (ref. Verse 7, which spiritually means seeking for their own righteousness.) This is the reason why prophet Isaiah spoke in chapter 64:6 of his book that all our righteousness are as filthy rags. When they heard the voice of God walking in the garden, they hid themselves from the presence of God, which was quite unusual of them. However, when confronted by God, Adam said he heard the voice of God in the garden, and was afraid because of his nakedness and therefore hid himself. As soon as God sought to know how Adam became aware of his nakedness, Adam aggressively told the Lord in verse 12, "You cannot blame me. It is this woman You gave me that caused me to disobey you. Therefore it is Your fault for giving me this sinful woman who has caused me to sin against You." The presence of sin consciousness that produced inferiority complex in him, did not allow Adam to be sober with what he did and therefore repent of his sins. He quickly defended and justified himself, and shifted the blame to God and Eve. Adam was so aggressive in his response that he did not give room for any reconciliation between them and God. The merciful and righteousness God who was still open for reconciliation, inquired from the woman why she broke His commandment. The woman was not sensitive to know that by being sober and repentant, she could still restore that lost relationship. In her response in verse 13, she indicated that the fault was not hers, but the following people: -

- (1) God who created the serpent.
- (2) Adam who did not put a serious check on the serpent's activities in the garden since he was her head and also that of the serpent.
- (3) The serpent who rebelled against the authority channel of God by deceiving his master (man) and making him also to sin against God.

encing His judgment, which is what  
ove man away from that glorious place  
and placed cherubims to guard it. From that moment, man lost his  
right to approach God, and this began to rob him of faith in  
himself, in his fellow man, in God the Creator, and in the word of  
God. This sense of condemnation or sin consciousness holds man  
in serious bondage and he knows he's not good enough to pray and  
get answers to his prayers. If he prays, it is a prayer of desperation  
that whether God answers or not, he will do what his heart desires  
no matter the consequences. This sense of guilt, inferiority, failure  
and weakness makes man to reason, and that reasoning is called  
philosophy.

Man therefore moved into philosophy regarded as the search for  
knowledge, especially the nature and meaning of existence without  
seeking to make peace with God who is the Source of wisdom and  
knowledge of anything that man requires or that exists. And  
because man has developed a nature of sin consciousness, a spirit  
of inferiority complex, a sense of unworthiness, which dominates  
and rules him, he now has a sense knowledge faith that cannot  
know God nor find Him (Thomasø faith). This is why man goes  
about establishing all kinds of religions to get rid of the nature of  
sin consciousness and inferiority complex. But can religion help  
man to get rid of the nature of sin consciousness? No, because  
nobody can obtain God's righteousness by observing religious  
rules. This can only be obtained by believing on the death and  
resurrection of Jesus Christ, and giving up of our own will to do  
the His own will. God knew that His judgment on Adam and Eve  
will be the end of human race if He allows them to die physically  
at once just as they died spiritually. This is due to the fact that they  
had no children before they sinned. It was after their sin that they  
had children and that is the reason why the entire human race was  
born and conceived in sin until after the death and resurrection of  
Jesus Christ who nailed all sins on the cross of Calvary, thus  
making way for anybody that believes on Him to become the  
righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. God's desire to have man by

led since man has the very spirit of God  
God again to act on the principle of grace  
and truth, and in verse 21 of Genesis chapter 3 (Gen.3:21), God  
allowed Adam and Eve to reopen fellowship with Him but not  
inside the garden, so as to be able to receive the blessings He has  
for the human race. By this act of grace, He killed some animals by  
Himself, and the blood atoned for the sins of Adam and Eve, and  
He (God) used the skins of those animals to make coats for both of  
them (a symbol of Robe of Righteousness) and clothed them,  
thereby rejecting their own self righteousness which came out of  
leaves and which bore no blood. God laid the sins of Adam and  
Eve on those two animals that were pure (i.e. without blemish),  
and their blood was used to remit the temporarily, the sins of  
Adam and Eve and make them walk in righteousness. This  
indicates that the righteousness of God could be obtained through  
the sacrificed blood of a sanctified vessel whose sin has been laid  
on an animal in the Old Testament or the Lord Jesus in the New  
Testament. If Adam and Eve had rejected the coats made by God  
Himself out of the skins of those animals, just like many reject the  
sacrificed blood of our Lord Jesus Christ which today produces  
righteousness for us, God would have wiped them away and that  
will be an abrupt end of the human race.

## WHY THE HUMAN RACE FAILED TO OBTAIN GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS AFTER THE FALL OF ADAM, UNTIL CHRIST CAME.

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Gen.4:1-2:- In all the years Adam and Eve lived in the presence of  
God before they sinned, Adam did not know the wife (i.e. have a  
carnal knowledge of her), so as to produce children in order to  
replenish the earth. It was only after they had sinned against God  
and were judged, condemned and driven out of the glorious  
Garden of Eden where there is no procreation, that Adam had a  
carnal knowledge of the wife. This resulted in the birth of Cain and  
later Abel. Adam and Eve though having their sins atoned for by

temporarily continue to deal with them, nature of sin consciousness, sense of unworthiness and inferiority complex before they began to multiply the human race. On the account of this, they gave birth to Cain and Abel with this sinful nature that has received the judgment of God. And so the whole human race was born with this Adamic and sinful nature until the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ who carried all those sins and nature of sin consciousness away having nailed all of them on the cross. This was the reason why King David said through the Holy Ghost in Psalms 51:5, that he was shapen in iniquity and that his mother conceived him in sin. Why? This is because both himself and his mother, who gave birth to him, were born with the same Adamic nature, which is already judged and condemned. This again was the reason why God spoke through Apostle Paul in Rom.3:23, that all (which includes man, woman, little children, new born babies, etc) have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. Truly speaking, we have all sinned because we all were born with the nature of Adam. And due to the sentence of death pronounced on this flesh, nobody could die and come out or resurrect again, because the devil who had power over death then, will hold the person in bondage (ref. Heb.2:14-15). Only by paying this gruesome price can any obtain God's righteousness. It was so frightening that nobody tried to pay this price. Everybody was looking for a temporary way of walking in righteousness, and for those who later got the vision and revelation of God's righteousness revealed to them, they quickly found the blood of animals as a temporary refuge to appease for them the wrath of God which protects the righteousness of God, and help them walk in righteousness required by the law for that age, pending the coming of Christ who is the righteousness of God.

**CAN ANYBODY'S RIGHTEOUSNESS SAVE ANOTHER IN THE OLD TESTAMENT?**

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ness of a father or a mother cannot save the righteousness of a brother or a sister cannot save his fellow brother or sister. This is because everybody had the sentence of death pronounced on him/her, therefore nobody is pure (i.e. without fault) before God. As we can see here, the atonement God made for Adam and Eve could not stand for Cain and Abel. Each of them needs to sacrifice for his own sins even as both had earlier chosen their occupations. When the time came, Cain offered a sacrifice from the fruit of the ground (flesh) which is already cursed, and which also does not have blood. His offering however, did not get any approval from the Lord, as his sins, which the blood would have covered if his sacrifice had blood, were not covered. On the other hand, Abel's sacrifice was received by the Lord and it covered the sins of Abel because it had blood. This is why God said that without the shedding of blood (will), there cannot be remission of sins (Lev.17:11; Heb.9:22). Cain became angry and killed his brother and because of inferiority complex, he was ready to challenge God when He asked him about Abel. This is why even in today's Christian fold, many people are fighting the righteousness of God because the sacrifices of many of their brethren are being received by the Lord, and their own are rejected because it is offered in the flesh and does not cover any sin.

Ezek.14:13-20:- The Lord again spelt it out through Prophet Ezekiel, indicating that nobody's righteousness will save another. He made it clear that everybody will work out his/her own righteousness to be able to deliver himself/herself from judgment and condemnation. Even in the New Testament after the death and resurrection of Christ, which gave those that believed on it righteousness, the righteousness of Brother B or Sister A cannot stand in for the other person. This is because if you fail to receive Christ as your Lord and Saviour, you cannot obtain the free gift of grace which is the fruit of righteousness. And if you fail to present

ice, holy and acceptable unto the Lord  
ever walk in righteousness.

## THE MYSTERY OF RIGHTEOUSNESS AND WHY JESUS CAME TO REDEEM THE HUMAN RACE.

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Heb.2:14-15:- In all the ages, the human race has been under a great curse from God, a curse of spiritual and physical death which paved the way for sin consciousness. A man who is dead spiritually cannot stand in the presence of God, this is why He drove Adam and Eve away from His presence because they became spiritually dead when they sinned.

Heb.9:7:- Also in Old Testament, the high priest could only enter the holy of holies (the presence of God) once in a year, and not stand there and start worshipping God, but to atone for the sins of the spiritually dead Israel after atoning for his own sins with the blood covering him. This was a clear indication that himself also was spiritually dead on account of Adamic nature, but the blood on his body gave a temporary relieve. Why did I say temporary? It is temporary because when he comes the following year on the day of atonement for another sacrifice, he must again atone for himself before atoning for the entire nation (Heb.10:1-3). After this atonement by a spiritually dead high priest for a spiritually dead nation, he will still come out of that frightening presence of God. And by doing this, the good Father was paving way for a High Priest who is spiritually alive to come and eternally unite the humanity and make them to be spiritually alive before Him. Jesus therefore came by the determined counsel of the Father and took the flesh and blood that had the sentence of death passed on it, so that by becoming sin and a substitute for human race, He might destroy the devil who had the power of death, and deliver the

ear of death, have been subject since the

Do you know that satan does not have one single authority over all of you who are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus? Satan cannot determine the death of anybody even unbelievers, because the power of death had been taken away from him and Jesus is the One holding the keys of death and hell (ref. Rev.1:18). The Lord Jesus conquered the devil, and made God's righteousness available to all. Until you know that you have been made the righteous by accepting the Lord Jesus as your personal Lord and Saviour, sin and disease will continue to rule over you. However, the day you have a revelation of what righteousness of God in Christ Jesus is, satan is defeated. Believers who walk in the spirit are not condemned (Rom.8:1), even if they sin, the Spirit of God in them will convince them that they have missed it, and they will repent. But there is still condemnation for those who have accepted the Lord Jesus and still allow their nature of sin consciousness to govern them by walking in the flesh and producing the works of the flesh (ref. Gal.5:19-21).

II Cor.5:21:- God laid our sins on Him (Jesus) who had no knowledge of sin, so that we will be called the righteousness of God in Him. We should be called the righteousness of God not outside Him or beside Him, but inside Him. That means that once we don't receive or do anything inside Him, we are not walking in His righteousness, and this will cause us to walk in sin consciousness and inferiority complex.

Heb.9:11-28:- The great mystery that is in righteousness is that when the Old Testament priests enter the holy of holies once in a year, they must come out after performing the atonement for both themselves and the nation of Israel. But when Christ entered with His own blood, first of all, He did not need to cover Himself or sprinkle blood upon Himself, because He came in with His soulful body which is full of flesh and bones and which does not have any



l upon it. He has removed His sinful and  
) , which is what the human race is  
supposed to pay as a penalty so as to overcome death, which is the  
root cause of man's bondage and fear. Secondly, after purifying the  
heavenly things with His sinless blood according to the manner of  
the Old Testament, He did not go out again like the Old Testament  
priests used to do when they finish atonement, but rather sat down  
at the right hand of the Father, and removed the veil (flesh) which  
was a big stumbling to dwelling in God's Holy Hill (Presence), He  
also removed every other thing that will pose a great obstacle to  
our coming to meet Him there. After all those things, He opened  
His mouth and invited everyone who is seeking for God's  
righteousness to come boldly (i.e. without feeling inferior or  
allowing sin consciousness to stop you from that glorious blessing  
of going to meet Him there, because they have been dealt with) so  
as to obtain by force what belongs to you (Heb.4:16). Jesus knew  
that by dying, resurrecting and ascending to the throne of the  
Majesty, He will permanently dwell there in God's presence to be  
our advocate (ref. I John 2:1-2), and so when He was giving out to  
His disciples what appeared to be one of His last messages, He  
said that anyone who believes on Him will do the same works He  
is doing, and shall even do greater works, because He is going  
back to the Father to stay as our everlasting High Priest. And  
because He is permanently dwelling in the presence of God as our  
High Priest, He daily presents as many as have received Him and  
walk in His righteousness holy, unblameable and unreprouvable  
before God (Col.1:12-23), so long as they continue to meet the  
requirements of the blood which the Lord used to pay for the price  
of our sins.

## THE DAMAGING EFFECTS OF SIN CONSCIOUSNESS OR SENSE OF CONDEMNATION ON THE HUMAN RACE.

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There are two kinds of sense of condemnation :-

the effect of sin consciousness is to the  
an race (unbelievers).

- (b) The second kind and effect is to the regenerate human race (born again Christians) who are yet undeveloped in their Christian beliefs and therefore know nothing about their rights and privileges in Christ Jesus.
- (A) The Unregenerate Human Race :- (Eph.4:17-19, Eph.2:11-12, Gal.4:8, Ithess.4:5). This group of people are totally alienated from God according to these scriptures. They have no knowledge of whom God is and have also not accepted the righteousness of God which is Christ Jesus. They are walking in rebellion against God by refusing to accept the free gift of grace God has given to all mankind. They are still in their Adamic/sinful nature, and cannot approach God for He does not hear abominable prayers or the prayers of a sinner (Prov.28:9, Prov.21:27, John 9:31). They are spiritually dead because of the sin disease that is in sin consciousness. Their consciences are reprobate and dead. They are afraid of God, of themselves, of their fellow human beings, of animals, of death, etc. They are living in great bondage of fear and satan is making a mince of them. They are in serious inferiority complex because of the presence of sin consciousness in their nature, and this makes them go about establishing all kinds of religious sects as a way of reopening a lost fellowship with God. They have totally lost their legal right to fellowship with God because of condemnation. They keep on looking for who will pray for them because of sense of condemnation or sin consciousness.
- (B) The Regenerate Human Race:- (ref. Icor.3:1-4, Heb.5:12-14, Ipet.2:1-3, Gal.4:1-3). These group of believers which consist of the majority in the Christian fold, are those that have received the free gift of grace and

righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. Even those who have been born again, baptized in water and the Holy Spirit, they are still walking with sense of condemnation or sin consciousness because they lack the knowledge of their legal right in Christ Jesus and satan has capitalized on the ignorance of this group of people to be denying them of their rights and privileges (Hosea 4:6). And because of this their ignorance of the word of God, and also not being able to discern what the righteousness of God is, they are totally kept under some kind of religious laws that are contrary to the word of God either by themselves, or by the heads of these religious groups (Rom.1-6). Due to the fact that law is the revelation of sin, disease, fear and death, etc. And satan the defeated foe, continues to reign and dominate their lives (rom.6:11-16). They believe they are still babies in Christ Jesus who need the help and services of a spiritual guide to attain the righteousness of God. And this their spiritual guides keep them under their own religious laws as a way of achieving the righteousness of God. They have a sense of unworthiness which produces inferiority complex that destroys their faith, robs them of peace of mind, and makes them have an ineffectual and zealous prayer life. And by so doing, they have been ever searching to find somebody that can pray the prayer of faith for them. This sin consciousness has also caused them to be spiritual failures because, instead of trusting God and walking in God's kind of faith, they trust man and walk in sense knowledge faith which makes them question the moves of God when it goes contrary to their beliefs, and walk in rebellion against God by refusing to surrender their will to God. They still live their lives as Christians under total condemnation of the enemy and attack anybody that tries to get them out of this error. They are very sensitive to worldliness and walk in evil surmising. They oftentimes

ins they have forsaken because they bes, they are not competent enough to overcome it (those sins). They are deceived by the enemy that they are not yet God's righteous ones and therefore not matured to avoid certain sins. Their word is "God will understand why I did it, or why I have to do it." Poor people, God does not understand anything as an excuse to indulge in sin.

## WHAT THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD RESTORED TO US

There is nothing that can be better understood in the scripture or in theological terms than righteousness, because in it is everything that the human race is craving for. It is because of what the human race will gain from righteousness that has brought the formation of all these religious groups. Both paganism and modern day religions are all part and parcel of mankind's desire for the thing that righteousness gives to humanity. Righteousness restores to man all that he lost in the Garden of Eden plus an additional new relationship as a son of God with all the rights and privileges that follow sonship. Righteousness is not obtained by experience, even though it will pave way for a lot of experiences, it is rather the nature of God the Father imparted to us so as to ascend until we know that we are what God says we are ó Masters, Sons, gods, creators, conquerors, etc.

## THE BREAKDOWN OF WHAT THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD RESTORED TO US.

- (a) Righteousness has restored our perfect standing with God:- The righteousness of God that made us new creation restored our standing perfectly with God, thereby taking away our old nature of sin consciousness which has denied us of all our spiritual assurance, initiative and confidence in the presence of our Holy God. It gave as many as have received it, and are

perfect standing in the presence of the Father which our Saviour Jesus Christ had with the Father when He was on earth. Jesus was not afraid of the Father, because He was sinless and knew He has a legal right to walk in the Father's presence. He was not afraid of satan because He knew He is the Master over satan and all his forces of darkness. He also knew He is the Master over the human, animal, vegetable and mineral kingdoms. He knew He is the absolute Ruler over the laws of nature. He had no sense of inferiority over anything He comes across because He is the Master of anything that is in existence. Righteousness is a thing of mastership once restored to you. It makes you a master over everything like it did to Christ. You could disease, sickness healed, and it will be done because you have a right standing with God and know your legal right. With righteousness, you have power over satan like Jesus did.

- (b) Fellowship with the Father is restored through righteousness:- Righteousness restores to human race, the lost fellowship with God, and as a guiltless child can approach the father with the same liberty and freedom which the Lord Jesus used to approach His Father, this is the same way as many as have received this gift of grace to be the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus can approach and address God the Father. Just as Jesus walked with the Father without having the sense of sin, the sense of guilt, the sense of condemnation, the sense of lack of money, lack of love, lack of knowledge or lack of ability in any aspect of His life, this is what God's righteousness should produce in us. He had no sense of sin consciousness, He had no inferiority complex, the righteousness which He had, gave Him the sweetest and most perfect fellowship with the Father, and it will do the same for us today. Why? Because as He is, so are now.

restored our faith in God and in His word:- The righteousness of God restores to humanity the lost faith. Jesus believed in His ability to restore humanity by accepting to come and pay that price. He believed in His Father as being able to raise Him from the dead, and so when He was giving up His ghost on the cross of Calvary, He committed His Spirit into the hands of the Father (Luke 23:46). He believed in His mission, therefore all attempts by the devil to make Him lose His vision and be part of his Babylonish system either in word, thought or action failed, as He clearly maintained that He was not part of this kingdom (John 18:36). He believed in humanity, and that means that human race will accept His salvation and walk in the righteousness of God. He believed that satan will fall to the earth, and this was the reason why when the seventy disciples which He sent in Luke 10:1-24, came back with their report of how demons were subject to them, He told them that satan had already fallen. The righteousness of God will also cause us to believe all these things and act on them. He does not believe in sense knowledge faith like Thomas (i.e. except I see, hear and feel it, I cannot believe). This is the reason why He never prayed with Thomas and this is also why the modern religious movements which have so much of physical miracles, have challenged and deceived the faith of the multitudes that listen and attend their crusades and seminars. This is sense knowledge faith and does not make believers in it walk in righteousness or enjoy the fruits of what the righteousness of God has restored to us. Righteousness makes us pray a prayer of faith (not sense knowledge faith, but God's kind of faith) and have such prayers answered.

- (d) Righteousness has restored our peace:- It is only when you have the righteousness of God imparted in you, and you walk

have peace. Righteousness restores our this makes us live peaceable with men, unlike the wicked who are always restless (Isa.57:20-21). They are troubled like the sea because of sin consciousness and sense of condemnation. They are always afraid of lack and walk in sense of guilt, anxiety, the consciousness of problems and bills that have not been paid. Righteousness on the other hand, restores quietness and absolute rest to one's spirit, and we are confident that God will do what He has promised. The people that have received the righteousness of God and walk in it, will permanently dwell in a peaceable habitation and in unshakeable dwellings (Isa.32:17-18). Once you receive and walk in the righteousness of God, your faith will grow tremendously and you will begin to have a sense of superiority over your worries. This will then elevate your spiritual stand with God and you will begin to see yourself as a master over any situation.

- (e) Righteousness restored our freedom:- Righteousness restores to man freedom from sin consciousness, freedom from the bondage of fear of death and satan, freedom from the sense of inferiority, etc., which the human race has sought and struggled down through the ages. This is the kind of freedom that Jesus had. It is total freedom from being a spiritual failure or spiritually dead because we trust in God and lean not on our own understanding. We are no more afraid of depression through sense knowledge or circumstances which we find ourselves, because the righteousness of God has made us free. We now have a sound mind to walk in love. (IITim.1:7).
- (f) Righteousness has given us the right to be adopted as sons:- Righteousness has given us the right to be adopted as sons and this makes us to inherit all things that the Father has. We are His sons and He is our Father. We are all from the same

...aring the same family name (i.e. power,  
He has restored to us the unspeakable  
joy of fellowshiping with Him in Heaven, on the terms of  
equality (i.e. we are joint heirs with Christ who is the Heir to  
God and creators like Him), and what He did and is still  
doing, we will do.

## HOW TO WALK IN RIGHTEOUSNESS

In order to walk in righteousness, we have to know what constitutes the Holiness of God. The Holiness of God is made up of the Love of God which paid the price required by law and gave us the ability to walk in righteousness, and the Wrath of God which protects the righteous standards of God which have been broken. The Love of God and the Wrath of God are inside the Holiness of God, and both of them are irreconcilable. The Love of God wanted man to come back to God in sweet fellowship and to receive the great blessings of what God has stored for mankind, while the wrath of God was bent that the righteousness of God which had been broken, will be met, and the sinner will pay the price, of which it is death. On account of sin, nobody could die and resurrect to stand before the Father, until Christ who is the manifestation of God's love that came down to man, paid the price, and reconciled the broken relationship between His love and His righteousness. Both of them are now inseparable because you cannot walk in love without being the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus and be walking in it (righteousness), and also you cannot walk in righteousness without walking in love.

What then is love? Love according to (IJohn5:3, John 14:21 and John 15:10), is obedience to the word of God. If you don't obey the word of God, you can never walk in God's love. Again, to obey the Word of God, you must walk by faith, for faith that does not walk by works (love) is dead because it is alone. (James 2:17-26) Faith, love and righteousness are therefore interchangeable. Where is God's standard for walking in righteousness found? It is found in the word of God. We are made righteous by faith and I walk in



ctly obey the word of God. There is no  
hout having faith. Righteousness begins  
in faith and ends in faith, but there is never an end in faith because  
I will always live in the presence of God by faith.

John 8:31-32:- If you are a disciple of Christ Jesus, then He has  
commanded you to continue in His word and as you continue  
hearing His word and obeying it, then you are walking I both love  
and righteousness. What happens when you continue in the word  
of God? You will know the truth and the truth shall make you free  
from any kind of bondage.

MY AUTHORITY IN CHRIST JESUS BECAUSE OF THE
